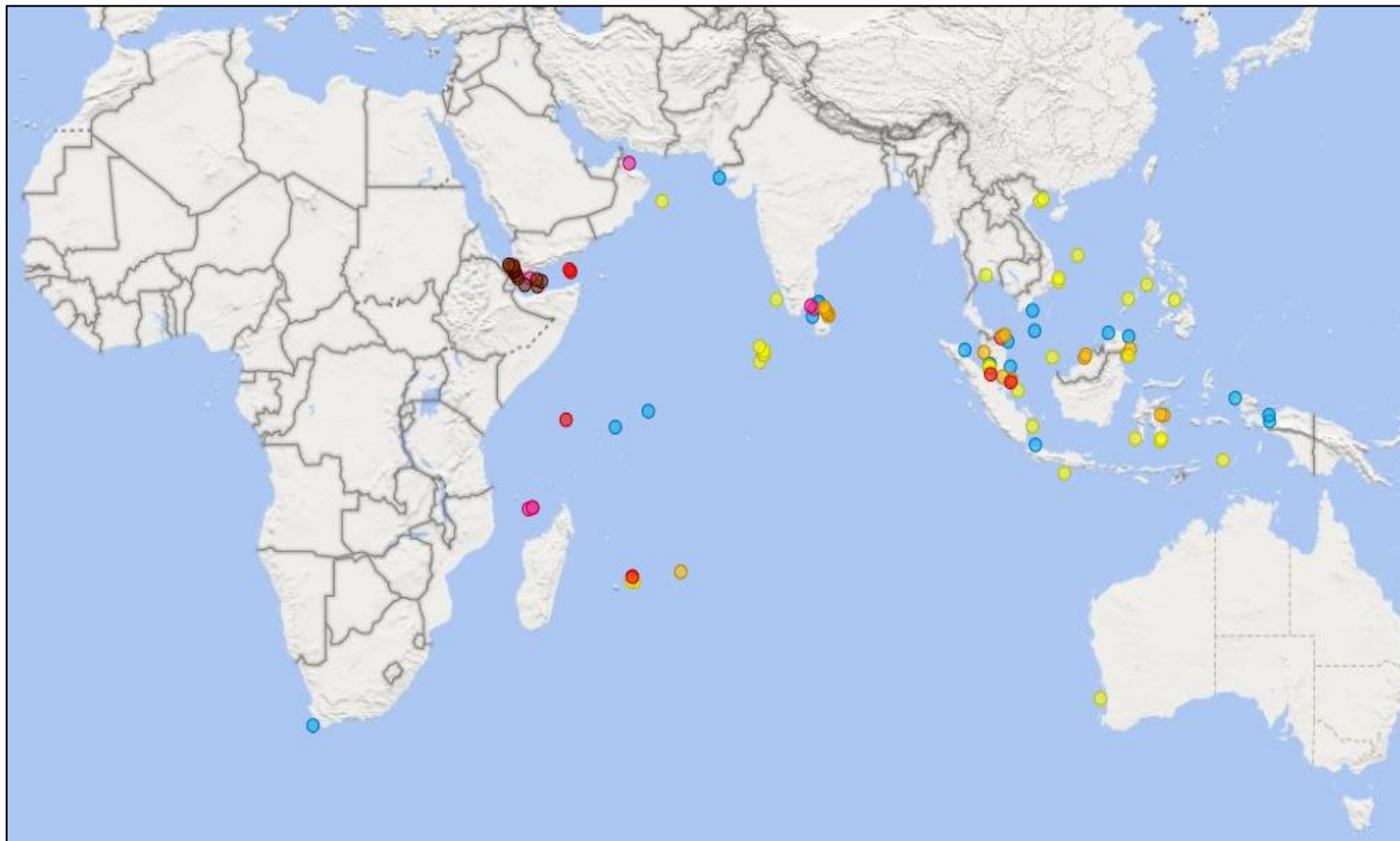

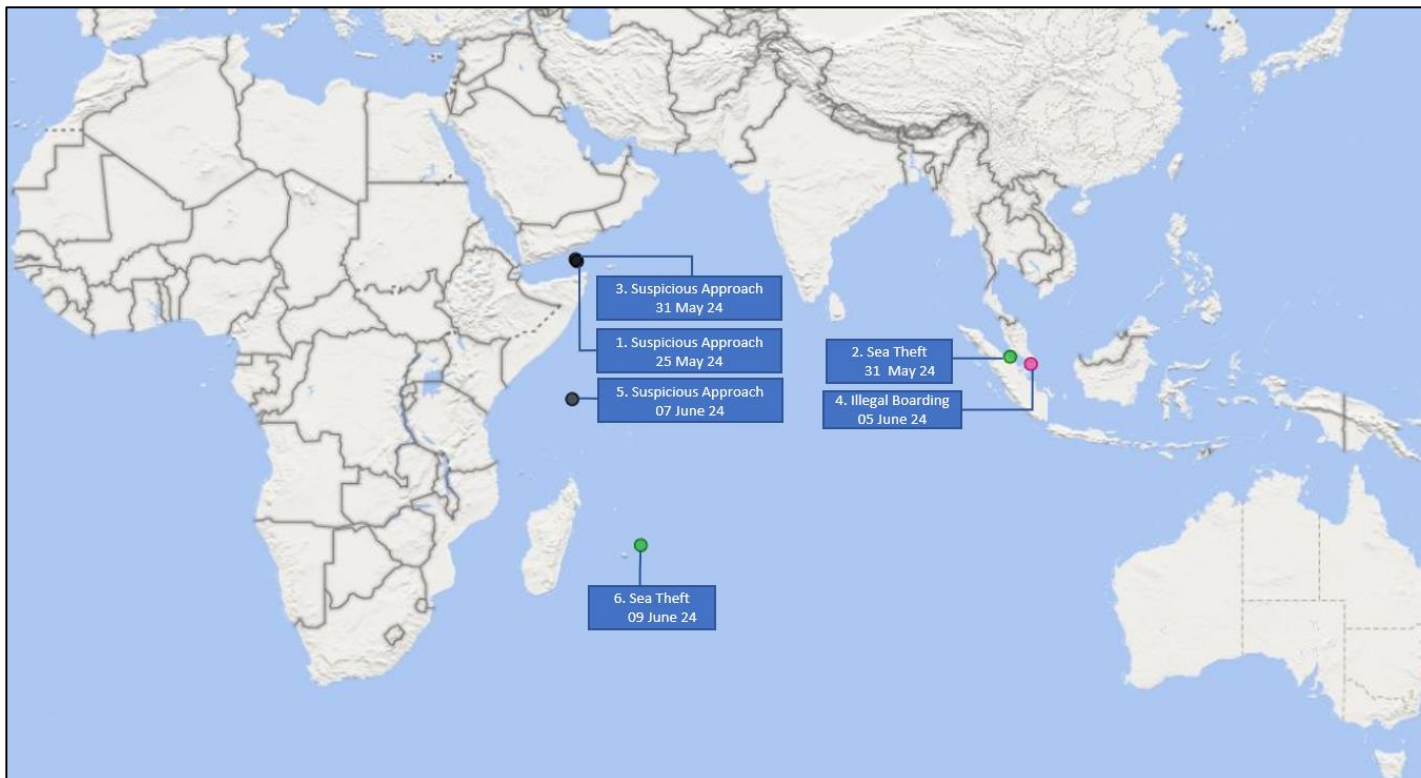

IFC-IOR Comment:- Based on the recent reports, the Centre has observed an upsurge in suspicious approaches off the coast of Somalia in the South Somali Basin. The analysis of incidents indicates that one of the Pirate Action Group operating near Central Somalia has likely moved South due to more favourable weather conditions in the South Somali Basin. All vessels are advised to exercise extreme caution, remain vigilant and maintain strict anti-piracy watch and measures. Masters are requested to report suspicious activities to the nearest law enforcement agencies and IFC-IOR (ifc-ior.gurugram@navy.nic.in).
