

RECRUITMENT OF CIVILIAN MOTOR DRIVER (OG)

1. The Written Examination for recruitment of Civilian Motor Driver (OG) was held on 21 Dec 19.
2. The list of candidates provisionally found eligible for Trade Test was published in Indian Navy Website on 02 Jan 2020.
3. The Trade Test for eligible candidates published in Indian Navy website on 02 Jan 2020 are scheduled to be conducted from 27 Jan to 04 Feb 2020. The Call Letters to the candidates have been despatched.
4. List of candidates with dates of Trade Test is enclosed to this notification.
5. If the name of candidate appeared in the list of eligible candidates (provisionally eligible for Trade Test) but the Call Letter is not received due to postal delay and change of address, the candidate can appear for Trade Test on the date, time, venue mentioned against names of candidates .
6. Candidates are to bring all original certificates along with two sets of Photocopies duly attested by a Gazetted Officer for verification.
7. The attention of the candidates is invited to the fact that this Call Letter is provisional and is subject to condition that the candidates possess the essential and desirable Qualifications prescribed for the Post. The candidates are advised to ensure that they possess the essential certificates with regard to Age, Educational Qualification, Caste (Latest Caste Certificate), Original Driving License for Heavy Vehicles and Experience etc. prescribed for the Post before reporting for Examination. If the candidates do not possess the essential / desirable Qualifications prescribed for the Post, they will not be allowed to attend Trade Test.
8. The candidates are requested to go through and comply with the instructions for candidates.
9. Please note that if the candidate fails to attend for Trade Test on date and time indicated, the candidature will be treated as cancelled.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. The probable duration of stay at Visakhapatnam will be for one day (the day of Trade Test). However, candidates should come prepared to stay at Visakhapatnam for one more day, in case Trade Test has to be extended due to unforeseen reasons.
2. Naval Base is located near Scindia Junction for which city buses from RTC Complex and Railway Station are available.
3. Candidates should bring Original copy of Photo ID issued by Govt.bodies (viz., Voter ID, PAN card, Passport, Aadhar Card, Driving Licence, etc.) for verification of identity.

4. Mobile Phones, Pagers, Calculator, Smart Watches, Books, Note Books and / or any other gadgets are not allowed in the Examination Centre. Candidates are advised not to bring any valuable/costly items/ mobile phones or any accessories to the Examination Centre, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured by the Examination Committee/Administration and if found any by the Board the same would be confiscated and the candidate will be disqualified.
5. Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person, resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the selection or using unfair means during the examination or writing irrelevant matter including obscene language or matter in the script(s) or misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall or harassing or doing bodily harm by the candidate to the staff employed for the conduct of the examination will disqualify the candidate and he/she will be dealt with serious action including detention by Police.
6. No travelling allowance and other allowances will be paid to the candidates by this Headquarters for attending the Trade test. The candidate has to make his/her own arrangements for boarding and lodging as well as transport to the place of examination.
7. It may be noted that this Call Letter is not an offer of appointment.
