17 **5100/04**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Principal Design Officer Grade-I (Construction) in the Indian Navy, Ministry of Defence, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Indian Navy, Principal Design Officer Grade-I (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.**—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

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
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5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

S.R.O. 103.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Military Engineer Services (Senior Barrack Stores Officer and Barrack Stores Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1988, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the military Engineer Services (Senior Barrack Stores Officer and Barrack Stores Officer) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Military Engineer Services (Senior Barrack Stores Officer and Barrack Stores Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1988, against Serial numbers 1 and 2 relating to the posts of Senior Barrack Stores Office and Barrack Stores Officer, under column 12, the following Note shall be inserted at the end, namely :—

O. 246.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Navy (Civilian Gazetted Design Officers Posts) Recruitment rules, 1978, the Navy (Class I Gazetted Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1969 in so far as they relate to the post of Senior Design Officer Grade II and the Navy (Class II Gazetted Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1969 in so far as they relate to the Post of Junior Design Officer except as respects things done or omitted is to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts in the Design Officers Cadre in the Navy, namely :—

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax and of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

S.R.O. 135.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Navy (Group 'C', Non-Industrial Posts, Drawing Office Staff) Recruitment Rules, 1985, in so far as they relate to the posts of Chief Draughtsman (Civil/Mechanical/Electrical/Construction/Armament/Artist/Charts.), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the president hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Chief Draughtsman (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical Construction, Armament and Cartographic), in the Navy, Namely :—

1. Short-title and commencement :—(1) These rules may be called the Navy Chief Draughtsman (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Construction Armament and Cartographic, Group 'B' Posts). Recruitment Rules 1999.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts classification and scale of pay :—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc. :—The method of recruitments to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Desqualifications :—No person,

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, except any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax :—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving :—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
