'D'), Fire Fighting Staff Recruitment Rules, 1982.

8.K.O.76 - In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions of Article 302 of the Constitution and in suppression of the Ministry of Defence Group 'C' and 'D' (Fire Service) posts Recruitment Order 1976, in so far as they relate to the posts in the Indian Navy except as respects things done or omitted to be done in pursuance of such suppression, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts of the Fire Fighting Staff in the Indian Navy, namely:

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application :—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number, classification and scales of pay :—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.

1. (1) Short title and commencement.—These rules may be called the Indian Navy (Group 'C' and Group

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, quali-

qualification and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualifications.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the

marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary for expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
