S.R.O. 195.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Navy Group 'C' (Non-Industrial Posts, Store House Staff) Recruitment Rules, 1984, in so far as they relate to posts of Foreman of Stores, Senior Storekeeper, Storekeeper & Assistant Storekeeper the President hereby issues the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Foreman of Stores in the Indian Naval Service of Defence, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Navy Group 'B' (Non-Industrial Posts, Store House Staff, Foreman of Stores) Recruitment Rules, 2002.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 2 of the Schedule annexed hereto.
3. Number, classification and scales of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 5 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 6 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.
5. Disqualification.—No person—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts: Provided that the Central Government may, if such a marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and his wife, relax the condition of such marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
