S.R.O. 235.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Navy Group 'C' (Instructional Staff) Posts Recruitment Rules, 1979, in so far as they relate to the posts of Civilian Educational Instructor, excepting respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain Group 'B' (Instructional Staff) posts in the Navy; Ministry of Defence, namely—

Article I. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Navy Group 'B' (Instructional Staff) Posts Recruitment Rules 2002.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Article II. Number, classification, scale of pay and method of selection.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 5 of the said Schedule.

Article III. Method of recruitment, age limit after qualification, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 6 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

Article IV. Disqualification.—No person having the following disqualifications shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

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5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons, to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time, in this regard.

Note : (a) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department to the post held by the concerned officer in the cadre/department to which he has been deputed; (b) With three years service in the cadre/department to which he has been deputed after appointment (not to a regular post in the scale of pay of Rs 5,500-9,000 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department); (c) Qualification upto 10th class in Physics or Mathematics as one of the subjects from a recognised University or equivalent.

- (ii) Possessing the following educational qualifications (any one of the following qualifications will be sufficient for appointment): (a) Post Graduate Degree with Physics or

Mathematics as one of the subjects from a recognised University or equivalent;

- (b) Bachelor's Degree in Education (B.Ed.) from a recognised University or equivalent.

Notes : 1.— Officers in the feeder grade will not be eligible for appointment on deputation on a permanent basis. Similarly, officers of feeder grade who shall be eligible for consideration for appointment to Civilian cadre/grade for promotion.

2.— Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre position held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/Department

of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not more than 50 years on the closing date of receipt of applications.

3.— Under section 17(1)(b) of the Civil Service Commission Act, 1968, the maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not more than 55 years on the closing date of receipt of applications.
