#### New Delhi, the 6th September, 2001

- S.R.O. 193.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Navy Group 'C' (Library and Cinema Staff post) Recruitment Rules, 1980, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' and 'C' posts of Assistant Library and Information Officer, Library Information Assistant, Cinema-Projectionist Grade-I, Cinema Projectionist Grade-II, Senior Cinema Projectionist in the Navy, Ministry of Defence, namely:
- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Navy Group 'B' and 'C' Library Staff and Cinema Staff posts Recruitment Rules, 2001.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number, classification and scales of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 1 to 4 of the said schedule.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.
  - 4. Disqualification .-- No person,---
    - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

का. नि. आ. 194. — राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परनुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए सशस्त्र बल चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय पुणे में स्वास्थ्य शिक्षक के पद पर भर्ती की पद्धति का विनियम करने वाले भर्ती नियमों का निम्नलिखित संशोधन करते हैं अर्थात् :—

- संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारंभ:—(i) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम सशस्त्र सेना चिकित्सा महाविद्यालय पुणे (स्वास्थ्य शिक्षक) भर्ती संशोधन नियम 2001 है।
  - (ii) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।
  - 2. लागू होना : ये नियम इससे उपाबद अनुसूची के स्तंभ 1 में विनिर्दिष्ट को लागू होंगे।
- 3. पद-संख्या, वर्गीकरण और वेतनमान :-- उक्त पद की संख्या, उसका वर्गीकरण और उसका वेतनमान वह होगा, जो इससे इन नियमों से उपाबद्ध अनुसूची के स्तंभ 2 से स्तंभ 4 में विनिर्दिध हैं।
- 4. भर्ती की पद्धित, आयु-सीमा और अन्य अर्हताएं आदि: उक्त पद पर भर्ती की पद्धित, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं और उससे संबंधित अन्य वातें वे होंगी जो पूर्वोक्त अनुसूची के स्तंभ 5 से स्तंभ 13 में विनिर्दिष्ट है। परनु सीधे भर्ती किए गये व्यक्ति के लिए विहित की गई ऊपरी आयु-सीमा केन्द्रीय सरकार द्वारा समय-समय पर जारी किए गए सामान्य आदेशों के अनुसार अनुसूचित जातियों और अनुसूचित जनजातियों और अन्य विशेष प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों की दशा में शिथिल की जा सकती है।
  - 5. निरहेता :—वह व्यक्ति,—
  - (क) जिसने ऐसे व्यक्ति से जिसका पति या जिसकी पत्नी जीवित है, विवाह किया है, या
- (ख) जिसने अपने पित या अपनी पत्नी के जीवित रहते हुए किसी व्यक्ति से विवाह किया है, उक्त पद पर नियुक्ति का पात्र नहीं होगा :

परन्तु यदि केन्द्रीय सरकार का यह समाधान हो जाता है कि ऐसा विवाह ऐसे व्यक्ति और विवाह के अन्य पक्षकार को लागू स्वीय विधि के अधीन अनुजेय हैं और ऐसा करने के लिए अन्य आधार हैं तो वह किसी व्यक्ति को इस नियम के प्रवर्तन से छूट दे सकेगी।

6. शिथिल करने की शक्ति:—जहां केन्द्रीय सरकार की यह राय है कि ऐसा करना आवश्यक या समीचीन है, वहां वह उसके लिए जो कारण है उन्हें लेखबद्ध करके तथा संघ लोक सेवा आयोग से परामर्श करके, इन नियमों के किसी उपबंध को किसी वर्ग या प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों की बायत, आदेश द्वारा शिथिल कर सकेगी।
